

Chaperone Expectations

Guidelines for Your Visit

The staff at G.WIZ would like to thank you for volunteering to chaperone today. We do our best to make sure that all our visitors have an enjoyable experience during their visit. Please take a moment to read through the following expectations. Following these guidelines will ensure the safety of our visitors as well as our exhibits.

Please make a copy of the guidelines for each chaperone in your group.

- Chaperones are **REQUIRED** to remain with students at **ALL TIMES**.
- Please remind your students to walk in the museum; we want them to see everything.
- Shoes must be worn at all times, especially at the Sprint Station exhibit.
- Please respect other visitors and ask your students to use inside voices at all times.
- Please have your students clean up after themselves, especially in the picnic area and the bathrooms. (Have one chaperone inside the restroom with students)
- Please remind your group to keep their hands behind their backs while visiting the habitat area. Bacteria can be transferred both directions.
- Please use the low viewing window for smaller children to see the fish & turtle pond.
- Food and drink are only permitted in the snack area or outside (including gum and candy). Please keep these items in the designated area.
- Please remind your students to treat all exhibits with respect. For the safety of all, please remind students that their feet are to remain on the ground at all times. Climbing is allowed only outside on the playground.
- Please ask students to use stairs; the elevator is reserved for guests with special needs.
- When visiting our gift shop, please limit the number of students to 5 at a time. One adult from the group **MUST** be in the gift shop when students are shopping.
- **STUDENT BEHAVIOR** is the **RESPONSIBILITY** of the chaperones.
